Success in the High Court

On 17 December 2025, the High Court of Australia allowed in part the appeals of the lead plaintiffs in the Sydney Light Rail class action. This decision restored the outcome reached by the trial judge in favour of two of the lead plaintiffs, Hunt Leather and Ancio Investments.

Banton Group, a specialist litigation law firm, is leading the claim on behalf of plaintiffs and group members and is currently inviting new registrations from potential group members in the proceedings. Signing up allows Banton Group to assess whether you may be eligible to participate as a group member in the proceedings.

Mediation with Transport for NSW begins on 30 June 2026.

You May Be a Group Member If You:

- Owned property near the works and suffered rental loss.
- Lived near the construction and experienced disruption, lost sleep, expense or distress.

Examples of impacts include:

- Lost trade or significantly reduced profits.
- Rental income lost or tenancies vacated.
- Years of noise, dust and vibration.
- Access to your premises being blocked or restricted.

- Your business operations or daily life being disrupted.
- Out-of-pocket expenses forced upon you.

Sign Up Information

Group members are not liable to pay upfront legal costs of the class action.

The proceedings are funded by a third-party litigation funder. If you receive an award of damages, you may be required to contribute towards legal costs and the litigation funder's commission from your damages award.

However, those amounts will not exceed the amount of any damages award and you will not be out of pocket for any costs.

As part of the sign-up process, we will ask you to provide us with various documents to help us assess whether you are a group member in the proceeding and may have a claim for compensation.

If you do not have all the documentation at hand, you can still provide your contact details and provide the supporting documents later.

The type of information you will be asked to provide when registering depends on whether you were a resident, held and leased property, or operated a business within the vicinity of the CBD and South East Light Rail Line (L2, L3).

Funding & Costs

- At the mediation, the parties will seek to agree to a settlement of the proceedings.
- Accordingly, if you wish to sign up as a potential group member, we would appreciate if you could please do so as soon as possible and by 30 June 2026*.

What Happens Next

Sign up as a potential group member so Banton Group can assess whether you may be eligible to participate in the proceedings and have a claim for compensation.
